

Medication Reconciliation

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The objective of this measure is to perform a medication reconciliation when you receive a patient from another setting of care or provider of care or when you believe an encounter is relevant.

Measure

The MIPS-eligible clinician performs medication reconciliation for at least one transition of care in which the patient is transitioned into the care of the MIPS-eligible clinician.

Denominator

Number of transitions of care or referrals during the performance period for which the MIPS-eligible clinician was the recipient of the transition or referral or has never before encountered the patient.

Numerator

The number of transitions of care in the denominator where medication reconciliation was performed.

Threshold

The numerator must be one or more.

Scoring

This measure contributes up to 10% to the ACI performance score.

Bonus (up to 15%)


Complete bonus measures to improve your ACI score.

Performance (up to 90%)

Complete additional measures to improve your ACI score.

Base (50%)

You must complete all required measures to meet the base score. You must achieve the base score to get credit in the ACI category.



Eyefinity EHR Instructions

When you receive a patient from another setting, scan any medication lists from the referring provider and save the file as a PDF. There are two parts to performing medication reconciliation.

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Recording the Referral

1. In Eyefinity EHR, create a **Visit Note**.
2. Look for the Visit Setting tile and tap **Manage**.

3. Tap the **Is Transition of Care** toggle to turn it on.
OR
On the web, select **Yes** from the **Transition of Care** drop-down menu.

4. Tap **Save**.

Performing the Medication Reconciliation

1. In Eyefinity EHR on the web, create a **Visit Note**.
2. Click the **Patient Clipboard** action bar icon.
3. Click the **Medications** tab.
4. If you are reviewing a scanned document, click the **Compare with Attachment** action bar icon.

OR

If you received a CCD, click **Transition of Care**, select the medications that you want to import, and skip to step 6.

5. Select a scanned file from the right side of the page to review or click **Browse** to locate a scanned file on your network and click **Upload**.
Alternatively, you can take a photo of the medication list with the iPad.
6. Review the medication lists. Medications prescribed by your practice appear on the left, and medications from external providers appear on the right.
7. Click **Save** when you are finished reviewing the medication list.
8. Document the rest of the exam and finalize the visit note.
