

Immunization Registry Reporting

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The objective of this measure is to submit electronic data to health registries.

Measure

The MIPS-eligible clinician is in active engagement with a public health agency to submit immunization data and receive immunization forecasts and histories from the public health immunization registry/immunization information system (IIS).

Active engagement can be achieved through any one of the following options:

- **Completed Registration to Submit Data.** The MIPS-eligible clinician registered to submit data with the PHA to which the information is being submitted; registration was completed within 60 days after the start of the performance period; and the MIPS-eligible clinician is awaiting an invitation from the PHA to begin testing and validation. This option allows MIPS-eligible clinicians to meet the measure when the PHA has limited resources to initiate the testing and validation process. MIPS-eligible clinicians that have registered in previous years do not need to submit an additional registration to meet this requirement for each performance period.
- **Testing and Validation.** The MIPS-eligible clinician is in the process of testing and validation of the electronic submission of data. MIPS-eligible clinicians must respond to requests from the PHA within 30 days; failure to respond twice within a performance period would result in that MIPS-eligible clinician not meeting the measure.
- **Production.** The MIPS-eligible clinician has completed testing and validation of the electronic submission and is electronically submitting production data to the PHA.

Exclusion

Any MIPS-eligible clinician (EC) who meets one or more of the following criteria may be excluded from the Immunization Registry Reporting measure:

- The EC does not administer any immunizations to any of the populations for which data is collected by its jurisdiction's immunization registry or immunization information system during the performance period.
- The EC operates in a jurisdiction for which no immunization registry or immunization information system is capable of accepting the specific standards required to meet the certified EHR definition at the start of the performance period.
- The EC operates in a jurisdiction where no immunization registry or immunization information system has declared readiness to receive immunization data as of six months prior to the start of the performance period.


Scoring

This measure is part of the Public Health and Clinical Data Exchange objective. Two measures from this objective are required to achieve a promoting interoperability score. The Public Health and Clinical Data Exchange objective is worth up to 10 points.

Eyefinity EHR Instructions

If you administer immunizations, you can fulfill this measure in Eyefinity EHR.

1. In Eyefinity EHR on the web, search for the patient.
2. Click the **Patient Clipboard** action bar icon.
3. Click the **Immunizations** tab.
4. Click **Add Immunization**.



5. Select or type the immunization information as needed.
